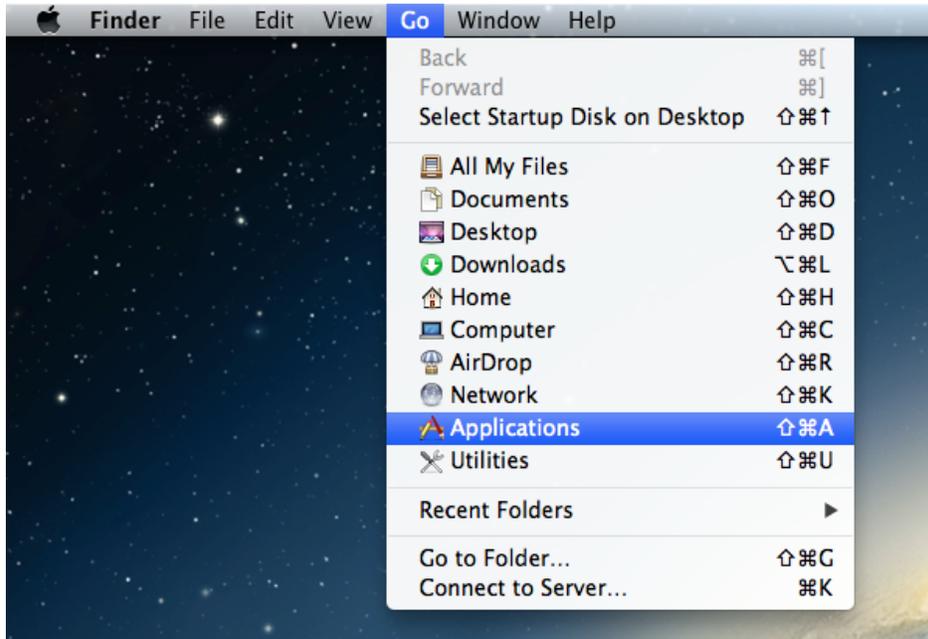


Mac SSH & file Transfer

To launch SSH on Macintosh Personal Computers and Macintosh Desktops:

1) From Top menu bar, click on “Go” > Applications



2) Find the Terminal icon/application and click to start



3) To launch SSH connection to the server, type the following command/prompt into the “Terminal” application:

```
ssh uwinuserID@bravo.cs.uwindsor.ca
```

For example: ssh smith@cs.uwindsor.ca



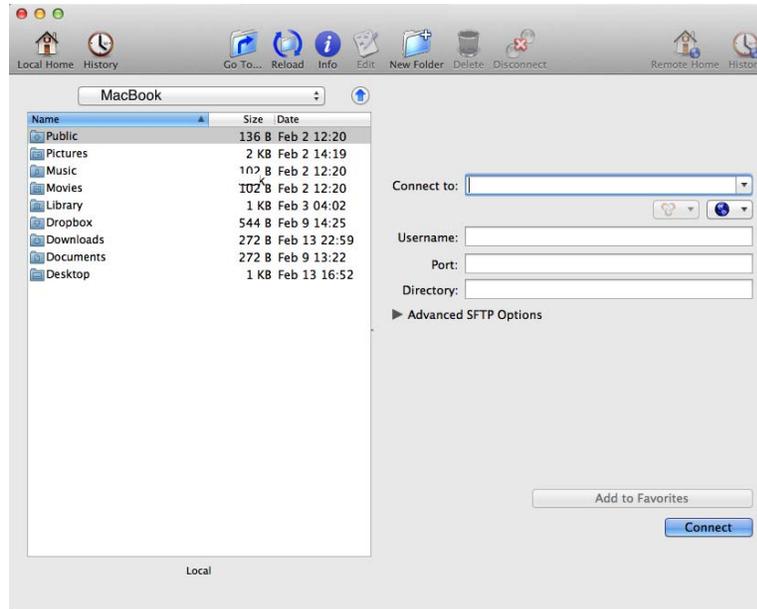
4) You may be asked to save the “**host key**” if it has not been seen before, accept or answer to the prompt with “**yes**” to save the key

5) Enter your uwindsor Password when prompted

6) Follow the linux commands provided on the class’s website.

File Transfer using Fugu:

1) Download fugu on your Mac platform and run it.



2) Fill in

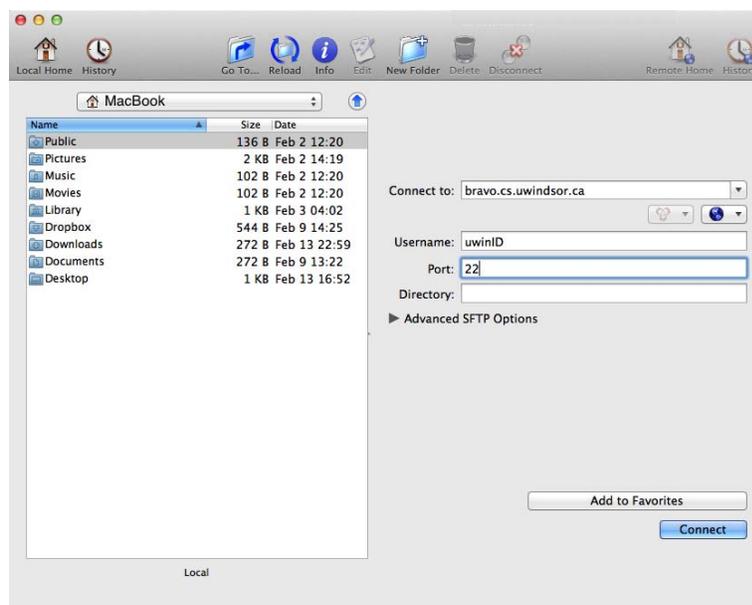
the required fields as follows:

Connect to: You can choose any server you wish
bravo.cs.uwindsor.ca
cs.uwindsor.ca

Username: uwinID

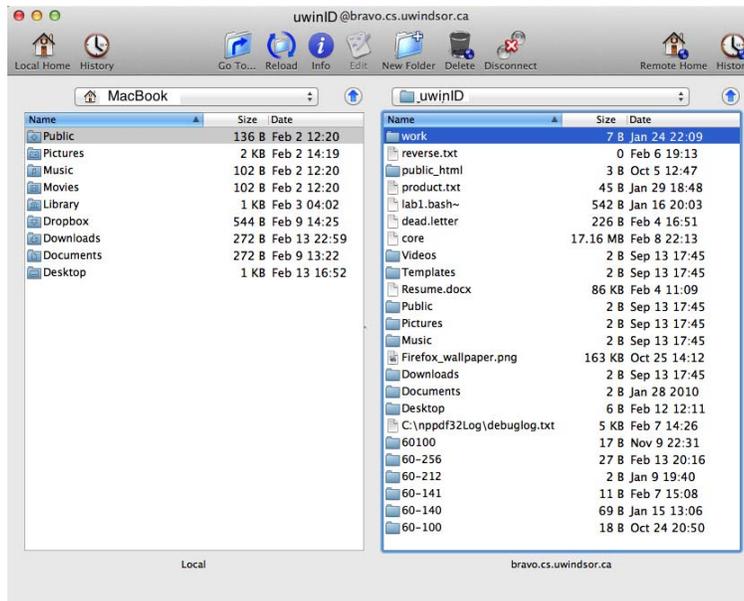
For example: **smith**

Port: **22**



3) Click on “**Connect**”, you will be prompted to enter a password

4) After successfully entering the password you will be connected to your directory. You can transfer files to and from the remote server by “drag-drop” from one computer to the other.
